

Len Howard Conservation Park was named after one of the Founders of the Peel Preservation Group. Len Howard was dedicated to preserving the Peel Inlet, the Harvey Estuary and Lake Clifton. The Park contains 60 hectares of bush on the north western shore of Peel Inlet and features a nature trail with boardwalks over wetlands.

BIRDS you may see on your walk include

- *Malurus splendens* – *Splendid Wren*
- *Coracina novaehollandiae* – *Black-faced Cuckoo-shrike*
- *Rhipidura leucophrys* – *Willie Wagtail*
- *Rhipidura fuliginosa* – *Grey Fantail*
- *Pachycephala pectoralis* - *Golden Whistler*

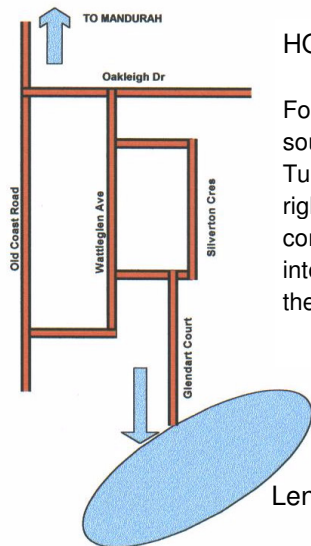
WATERBIRDS you may see on your walk:

- *Ardea novahollandiae* – *White-faced Heron*
- *Cygnus atratus* – *BlackSwan*
- *Threskiornis aethiopica* – *Sacred Ibis*
- *Platalea regin* – *Royal Spoonbill*
- *Anhinga melanogaster* – *Darter*
- *Phalacrocorax melanoleucos* – *Little Pied Cormorant*
- *Haematopus longirostris* – *Pied Oyster Catcher*

FROGS you may see or hear on your walk include:

- *Limnodynastes dorsalis* – *Western Banjo Frog*
- *Heleioporus eyrei* – *Moaning Frog*
- *Crinia insignifera* – *Brown Froglet*
- *Crinia pseudinsignifera* – *Western Froglet*

You may also come across *Tiliqua rugosa* better known as the Bobtail Skink.



HOW TO GET THERE

Follow the Old Coast Rd 5 km south from Mandurah to Erskine. Turn left into Wattle Glen Ave then right down Silverton Cres until you come to Glenart Crt. Turn right into Glenart Crt and the Park is at the end.
